

# Pauntley Church of England Primary School

## Sports funding

### Academic Year 2015-16

Funding received= £8,150

When the funding was first introduced we decided to spend it in the following ways:

- To hire specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside our teachers when teaching PE to increase their professional knowledge, skills and confidence when teaching sport
- To improve the quality and quantity of materials for PE/sport in our school
- To increase the provision of places and clubs for pupils outside school hours
- To provide high quality training for any adults, other than teachers, who want to, or are running an after school sports clubs
- To increase the professional development opportunities in PE/sport for all our teachers which might include providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE/sport
- Working alongside our local secondary school, and 13 local primary schools to increase access and participation in sport competitions and school games
- To pay for transport to and from any sporting events organised locally and further afield
- To fund extra enhancing swimming lessons for any of our junior children

So far we have spent the following amount of our funding:

**£750 on an enhanced service level agreement with our local secondary school (Newent School).**

This money allows a teacher from the PE department at Newent to have the equivalent of one day off a week during the academic year.

The service includes:

- ❖ Support for the delivery of twilight inset sessions focussed on three main aspects of the curriculum (knowledge and understanding of the National Curriculum, assessment within PE and development of KS1 PE)
- ❖ The planning, organisation and delivery of the following sports: Swimming, Cross Country, Rugby, Football, Hockey, Netball, Athletics, Rounders, Tennis and Cricket.
- ❖ A minimum of two activity specific inset sessions
- ❖ A minimum of two assessment related inset sessions
- ❖ A minimum of two KS1 festivals
- ❖ 5x50 minutes of support specific to the needs of the school

**£100 on joining a wider Primary School Sport Collaborative in the Forest of Dean.**

This cost allows our school to have individual school membership of the Youth Sport Trust and access to CPD opportunities held across the Forest of Dean during this academic year.

**£2,421 on a partnership with Superstars.**

This cost allows us to have a specialist PE coach to come into school one afternoon a week. The PE specialist will plan lessons and current teaching staff will teach alongside the specialist, therefore improving their own practice.

The PE specialist will also run an after school PE club.

**£733.98 on new PE/Sport resources.**

The new resources will ensure the PE curriculum is fully inclusive. Some of the money was used to fund new equipment for the playground.


**£1,080.35 on transport to sporting events and festivals.**

Pauntley is a very small school in a rural location. Before the PE and Sport Premium was introduced the children did not attend any sporting events or festivals. The pupils now attend several events each year.

**£228 on extra swimming lessons**

The junior children received extra swimming coaching on top of the national curriculum entitlement.

**£5,313.33 spent**



## Impact

- Increased pupil participation in sporting events and competitions. In 2015/16 all of the junior children competed in at least one sporting competition.
- There has been increased pupil participation in extra-curricular clubs.
- There has been an increased range of opportunities for the pupils.
- Staff have felt more confident and competent in the teaching of PE due to the partnership with Superstars.
- Pupils have positive attitudes to health and well-being.
